Tuna, turkey or SunButter and jelly sandwiches on whole wheat bread or whole wheat bagels with cream cheese or margarine (dairy free) are always available.

A healthy, whole grain snack is available every morning. Ice cream or ices and fresh fruit are served as a snack in the afternoon.

Special dietary concerns including kosher, gluten free, vegetarian and most food allergies can be accommodated.

Eagle's Landing is "Peanut Aware." All of our food is free of nut derivatives, including peanuts. All of our food is baked or grilled. Nothing is fried or contains trans fats.

Lucky Charm Cereal Milk Cupcakes

Ingredients:

Cereal Milk

3 cups milk
2 cup Lucky Charms Cereal

Cereal Milk Cupcakes

1 1/2 cups all-purpose flour
1 tsp baking powder
1/4 tsp salt
1/2 cup unsalted butter, room temperature
1 cups sugar
2 tbsp vegetable oil
1 large egg
1 egg white
3 tsp vanilla extract
1/2 cup + 2 tbsp cereal milk (from above)
1/3 cup rainbow sprinkles



Instructions:

1. **Cereal Milk:** add the milk and Lucky Charms to a bowl and let sit for 30-40 minutes. Strain the milk and discard the cereal. (set the extra aside for another batch).
2. **Cupcakes:** prepare a cupcake pan with cupcake liners and preheat the oven to 350°F
3. Combine the flour, baking powder, and salt in a medium sized bowl and set aside.
4. Add the butter, sugar and oil to a large mixing bowl and beat together until light in color and fluffy (about 3 mins).
5. Add the eggs one at a time, mixing until mostly combined after each. Add the vanilla extract with the second egg.
6. Add half of the dry ingredients to the batter and mix until mostly combined.
7. Slowly add the cereal milk and mix until well combined. Add the remaining dry ingredients and mix until well combined and smooth. Do not over mix the batter.
8. Fill the cupcake liners about 3/4 full and bake for 14-16 minutes or until a toothpick inserted into the center comes out clean.
9. Remove cupcakes from the oven and place on a cooling rack to cool. Frost with your favorite vanilla buttercream and garnish with Lucky Charms marshmallows and cereal pieces. Enjoy!
