What to Bring and Leave at Camp

Please send the following items with your child every day in their backpack. Please clearly print their name on the tag provided on the back of the backpack:

- two bathing suits (wear one to camp)
- shorts
- underwear
- two towels
- plastic bag for wet clothing

Campers in Kiddie Kingdom will also receive a bag, which we call a *Bundle Bag*, to hold their additional items that stay at camp. This bag will be in your child's backpack. Please include the following items in addition to what will stay in their cubby:

- bathing suit
- extra sunscreen
- a complete change for clothing including underwear, socks, t-shirt, and shorts

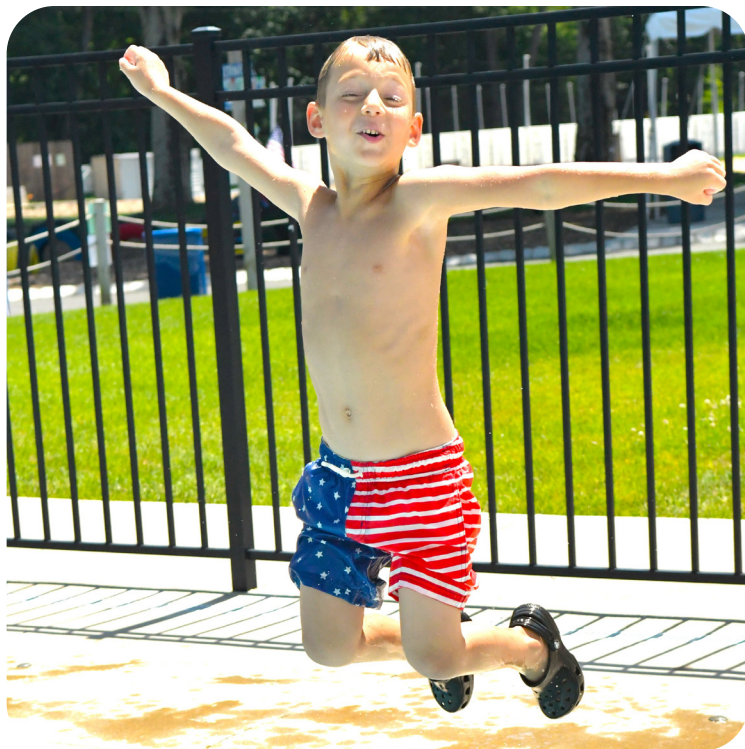




B5B BRINGS THE FUN

Cupcakes, Cookies, & Oreo Truffle Magic

Week 2 of Baking brought sweet surprises and rainy-day magic! Our youngest campers were busy whipping up sun butter cookies, a fun and delicious treat that had little hands busy mixing and rolling. Campers of all ages continued the cupcake fun, experimenting with exciting new flavors, creative toppings, and all kinds of decorating techniques — making every cupcake totally their own! But the real star of the week? The Oreo Truffles — our rainy day recipe. When the clouds rolled in, we got to work crushing Oreos, mixing in cream cheese, scooping them into little bites, and loading them up with fun toppings before finishing them off with a yummy white chocolate drizzle. We used both regular Oreos and Golden Oreos to have a variety (you can use any Oreo flavor). They were an absolute hit with all ages!



OREO TRUFFLES

Ingredients

36 Oreos (original), plus 3 more, crushed, for topping if desired
1 (8 oz) package cream cheese, softened
16 oz vanilla or chocolate candy melts, or melted white chocolate, milk chocolate or dark chocolate

Instructions

1. Line an 18 by 13-inch baking sheet with wax paper or parchment paper.
2. Place 36 Oreos in a food processor (entire cookie, don't remove cream filling) and pulse to fine crumbs.
3. Add cream cheese and pulse in bursts until well combined.
4. Scoop mixture out about 1 Tbsp at a time and form into 1 inch balls then align on prepared cookie sheet.
5. Place truffles in freezer for 15 minutes. Meanwhile crush remaining 3 Oreos.
6. Melt chocolate according to directions on package.
7. Remove truffles from freezer and dip in melted chocolate and use a spoon to pour some chocolate over the top then lift and allow excess chocolate to run off.
8. Return to baking sheet, immediately sprinkle tops with crushed Oreos and other toppings if desired, then allow chocolate to set. Enjoy!

INGREDIENTS:

4.5 cups flour
1 tsp baking powder
1 pinch of salt
3 cups milk
.5 cups vegetable oil
5 eggs separated
1 cup chocolate chip minis



DIRECTIONS:

Preheat waffle iron. In a large mixing bowl, sift together flour, baking powder, and salt. Stir in milk, oil, and egg yolks until mixture is smooth. In a separate bowl, beat egg whites until soft peaks form. Gently fold in egg whites with batter. Spray preheated waffle iron with non stick cooking spray. Add chocolate chips. Pour mix into hot waffle iron.

Cook until golden and hot! Enjoy!
