Special dietary concerns including Kosher, gluten free, vegetarian and most food allergies can be accommodated.

Eagle's Landing is "Peanut Aware." All of our food is free of nut derivatives, including peanuts. All of our food is baked or grilled. Nothing is fried or contains trans fats.

ONE SMART COOKIE

The bakeshop was buzzing this week with creativity and incredible aromas! Our youngest campers made Birthday Cake Mix Cookies — the perfect mashup of birthday cake and a classic cookie. Snickerdoodles are back and this year and 3rd and 4th grade campers get to have all the fun! They loved rolling the dough in cinnamon sugar before baking. The 5th and 6th grade campers crafted stunning Geode Cookies made with crushed Jolly Ranchers and colorful sugars — turning each one into a one-of-a-kind edible masterpiece. Upper Camp made the ever-popular Cookiedilla — a chocolate chip cookie sandwich filled with marshmallow fluff, caramel, and chocolate sauce. The perfect combo of crispy, gooey, and sweet!

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 tube refrigerated sugar cookie dough (or your favorite sugar cookie dough recipe)
- 1 cup powdered sugar
- 4 Tbsp. milk
- White, pink, blue and green sanding sugars
- Pink, blue and green rock candy, smashed



DIRECTIONS:

1. Preheat oven to 350°F and line two large baking sheets with parchment paper.
2. Roll small 1" balls out of sugar cookie dough and place them about 1 1/2" apart on the prepared baking sheets. Using your hands, press down on the cookie dough balls to make them look a bit misshapen. (You want them to look like rocks!) Bake for 12 minutes. Let cool completely before decorating.
3. Make the icing: In a small bowl, whisk together powdered sugar and 2 tablespoons of milk. If the icing is too thick, gradually add a bit more milk.
4. Roll the edges of the cooled cookies in icing, then roll the edges in colorful sanding sugar, alternating colors. Let set until the icing has hardened (about 15 minutes).
5. Working one cookie at a time, spoon more icing onto the center of each cookie. Drop a tiny bit of food coloring onto the icing then use a toothpick to swirl the food coloring to create an agate look. Sprinkle with white sanding sugar and more colorful sanding sugar, then decorate the cookie with rock candies. Let set completely before serving.

Try this yummy dish at home!

Baked Mozzarella Sticks:

Ingredients:

2 ½ cups bread crumbs
4 tbsp parm cheese, grated
4 tbsp olive oil
1 tsp Italian seasoning
2 eggs
½ cup flour
Mozzarella string cheese sticks
3 cups sauce



Directions:

Preheat oven to 375°F

1. Stir together cheese, olive oil, and Italian seasoning
2. Place breadcrumb mixture in a small dish. In another dish, add egg, fork whisked with a tablespoon of water. In third dish, place flour.
3. Unwrap cheese sticks, and roll each one first in flour, then egg, then breadcrumbs. Make sure each stick is well coated then place on greased baking sheet.
4. Bake 6-8 minutes, checking frequently until cheese is melted but not runny.
5. Serve hot with marinara sauce for dipping.
