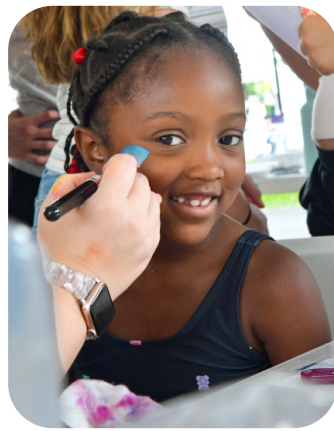
Our salad bar includes fresh mixed greens, grape tomatoes, tofu, cucumbers, carrot sticks, hard boiled eggs, pasta salad, chickpeas, edamame, fresh fruit, applesauce, shredded cheese, hard boiled eggs, non-fat fruit yogurt, pasta salad, lo mein salad, black bean taco salad, corn, and assorted dressings

Tuna, Black Bean Wraps, Kosher turkey, or SunButter and jelly sandwiches on whole wheat bread or whole wheat bagels with cream cheese or margarine (dairy free) are always available.

A healthy, whole grain snack is available every morning. Ice cream, ices, pretzels or fresh fruit are served as a snack in the afternoon.

Special dietary concerns including Kosher, gluten free, vegetarian, Halal, and most food allergies can be accommodated.

Eagle's Landing is "Peanut Aware." All of our food is free of nut derivatives, including peanuts. All of our food is baked or grilled. Nothing is fried or contains trans fats.



Makers at Work in Makerspace!

Makerspace has been such a hit so far this summer! We have worked on engineering projects, taken apart so many electronics in Tools N' Tech, had a 100% success rate of rocket launches in Rocketry, and made a bunch of cool projects in Wood Shop. Our 2nd graders have made paper spinners, clothespin coasters that they designed all by themselves, straw rockets, and pool noodle pom pom launchers. The 3rd graders made paper spinners during Week 1 and scrabble coasters in Week 2 where they practiced their spelling to design their coaster. They also did the umbrella STEM challenge where they used their STEM knowledge to build a contraption to keep a tissue from getting wet when water was poured on it. Lastly, we took it back to 2002 and recreated our very own 'mighty beanz' to play with and tumble around.

Our 4th graders started the summer off by making popsicle stick catapults, and then they built different kinds of buildings with Keva blocks which helped them learn about engineering. In Week 3, they made cotton ball launchers and this week they made hopping cup frogs, which were a huge hit.

Our 5th and 6th graders had lots of fun in their electives. In Rocketry, they built newspaper forts, launched potatoes (yes actual potatoes), and even launched actual rockets that they put together themselves. In Woodshop, campers made personal ping pong games, supply trays, and even catapults. Tools N' Tech was a 5/6 favorite so far this summer and they've taken apart everything from printers, to computer monitors and even old school boom boxes.

The 7th, 8th, and 9th graders have done many different things so far this summer, in Makerspace, they've made catapults, sling shot cars, and even Ferris wheels. They had an AMAZING rocket launch in rocketry, all the rockets went super high in the sky, and one even had a water landing in the pool! They also launched water rockets along with potatoes, made bottle cap cars, and built matchstick rockets. In Woodshop, they built their very own ring toss game, a 2-tier planter, and a rotating picture frame!

Overall, Makerspace has been filled with so many enriching activities that were all so much fun for everyone! We have so many more exciting things planned for the rest of the summer that you are going to need to "make space" for all your kids projects!

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 16 oz can refried beans
- Guacamole
- 1 lime, juiced (about 1 1/2 tbsp)
- 1/4 cup cilantro, chopped
- 1 tsp salt
- 1 1/2 cups sour cream
- 2 cups cheddar cheese, finely shredded
- 1/3 cup black olives, sliced
- 3/4 cup Roma tomatoes, diced
- 1/3 cup green onions, sliced

DIRECTIONS:

1. Combine the refried beans and taco seasoning in a bowl and whisk until combined. Spread into an even layer in a 7"x11" casserole dish.
2. In a separate bowl combine the avocado, lime juice, cilantro and salt. Mash until desired consistency is reached and then spread into an even layer over the beans.
3. Stir the sour cream until nice and smooth, then spread into an even layer over the guacamole.
4. Sprinkle the shredded cheese over the top of the sour cream, then top with the diced tomatoes, black olives, and green onions.
5. Cover with plastic wrap and keep chilled until ready to serve.

We started with the classic, golden, gooey original and then campers got to explore making cake batter crispy treats, fruity pebbles bars bursting with color, ooey-gooey s'mores squares, Oreo crispy treats packed with cookies-and-cream goodness, and even a funky chocolate Cheerio Chex mashup that everyone absolutely loved. Watching campers discover their new favorite combination made for one very sweet week in the kitchen!

INGREDIENTS:

1 1/2 cup Funfetti cake mix
1 large egg
1/4 cup oil
1/2 teaspoon aqua food coloring
7 ounce container of marshmallow cream
1 1/2 tablespoons butter
3 cups mini marshmallows
3 cups Fruity Pebbles



DIRECTIONS:

1. Preheat the oven to 350°F. For the first layer, mix together the Funfetti cake mix, egg, oil, and aqua food coloring. Press into a foil-lined, greased, 9x9" pan. Bake at 350°F for 10-12 minutes.
2. Remove the cake mix layer from the oven and put spoonfuls of the marshmallow cream on top. Allow the marshmallow cream to warm and spread out on its own. While waiting, work on the top layer.
3. For the top layer, make Fruity Pebble bars. Microwave 1 1/2 tablespoons of butter for 20 seconds in a large bowl, until melted. Add 3 cups of mini marshmallows and stir to coat. Microwave for 45 seconds and stir until smooth. (If the marshmallows aren't completely melted, microwave for an additional 30 seconds.) Mix in 3 cups of Fruity Pebbles. Drop large spoonfuls over the marshmallow cream layer and carefully spread out evenly. I put my hand in a plastic baggie with a little butter on it and gently spread it out and patted it down.

Store in an airtight container in the fridge for 4-5 days.
