Tuna, Kosher turkey, black bean wraps, or SunButter and jelly sandwiches on whole wheat bread or whole wheat bagels with cream cheese or margarine (dairy free) are always available.

A snack is available every morning. Ice cream, ices, pretzels or fresh fruit are served as a snack in the afternoon.

Special dietary concerns including Kosher, gluten free, vegetarian, halal, vegan, and most food allergies can be accommodated.

Eagle's Landing is "Peanut Aware." All of our food is free of nut derivatives, including peanuts. All of our food is baked or grilled. Nothing is fried or contains trans fats.

## Rainbow Pizza Rolls

### INGREDIENTS:

- 1 tube refrigerated pizza dough
- 1/2 cup pizza sauce
- 1 cup shredded mozzarella cheese
- 1/4 cup diced red bell pepper
- 1/4 cup diced orange bell pepper
- 1/4 cup diced yellow bell pepper
- 1/4 cup chopped broccoli
- 1/4 cup chopped spinach
- 2 tablespoons grated Parmesan cheese (optional)
- 1 teaspoon Italian seasoning



### DIRECTIONS:

1. Preheat the oven to 375°F (190°C) and line a baking sheet with parchment paper.
2. Roll out the pizza dough into a large rectangle.
3. Spread the pizza sauce evenly over the dough, leaving a small border around the edges.
4. Sprinkle the mozzarella cheese over the sauce.
5. Scatter the colorful vegetables evenly across the cheese.
6. Sprinkle with Italian seasoning and Parmesan cheese, if using.
7. Starting from one long side, roll the dough into a tight log.
8. Slice the log into 1-inch rounds and place each roll cut-side up on the prepared baking sheet.
9. Bake for 12–15 minutes, or until the rolls are golden brown and the cheese is melted.
10. Let cool for a few minutes before serving and enjoy!

Kid Tip: Encourage young chefs to arrange the vegetables in rainbow order before rolling the dough. It's a fun way to learn colors while making a tasty, colorful snack!

## Digital Adventures!

Computers here at Eagle's Landing covers a lot of ground, giving campers hands-on experience with two very different creative worlds: building games and making art. Our coding sessions run in Scratch, where campers learn that a game is really just a set of instructions telling a character what to do. Campers made pumpkin donuts that filled the whole room with sweet spice. We whipped up desserts inspired by s'mores, a campfire classic (for any season!), reimaged in all sorts of delicious forms. Then came sweet, cinnamon, buttery apple crescents, drizzled with caramel sauce for the perfect finishing touch. ### Apple Turnovers

#### **INGREDIENTS:**

1 tube (8 ounces) refrigerated crescent rolls  
1 cup apple pie filling  
1/2 cup confectioners' sugar  
1 to 2 tablespoons 2% milk



#### **DIRECTIONS:**

1. Preheat oven to 375°. Unroll crescent dough and separate into four rectangles; place on an ungreased baking sheet. Press perforations to seal. Place 1/4 cup pie filling on 1 half of each rectangle. Fold dough over filling; pinch edges to seal.
2. For mini versions, you can use the precut triangles of the crescent dough. Just add a tablespoon of filling instead.
3. Top with cinnamon sugar if desired.
4. Bake 10-12 minutes or until golden.
5. Place confectioner's sugar in a small bowl; stir in enough milk to reach a drizzling consistency. Drizzle over turnovers. Serve warm.
