Tuna, Kosher turkey, tuna, black bean wraps, or SunButter and jelly sandwiches on whole wheat bread or whole wheat bagels with cream cheese or margarine (dairy free) are always available.

A snack is available every morning. Ice cream, ices, pretzels or fresh fruit are served as a snack in the afternoon.

Special dietary concerns including Kosher, gluten free, Halal, vegetarian and most food allergies can be accommodated.

Eagle's Landing is "Peanut Aware." All of our food is free of nut derivatives, including peanuts. All of our food is baked or grilled. Nothing is fried or contains trans fats.

Muffins Galore and More

Try this best ever (and most versatile) muffin recipe at home:

INGREDIENTS:

2 cups all-purpose flour
3 teaspoons baking powder
1/2 teaspoon salt
3/4 cup white sugar
1 egg
1 cup milk
1/4 cup vegetable oil
Yields: 12 muffins



DIRECTIONS:

1. Preheat oven to 400°F (205°C).
2. Stir together the flour, baking powder, salt and sugar in a large bowl.
3. Make a well in the center.
4. In a small bowl or 2-cup measuring cup, beat egg with a fork.
5. Stir in milk and oil.
6. Pour all at once into the well in the flour mixture.
7. Mix quickly and lightly with a fork until moistened, but do not beat.
8. The batter will be lumpy. **DO NOT OVERMIX.** This will create tough/heavy muffins.
9. Fold in your favorite variation.
10. Pour the batter into paper lined muffin pan cups.
11. Bake for 25 minutes, or until golden

Variations:

- Blueberry: Add 1 cup fresh blueberries.
- Chocolate chip: Add 1 cup chocolate chips (mini chips work great too!)
- Apple cinnamon: Add 1 1/2 cups chopped apples and 1 Tbsp cinnamon
- Double chocolate: Replace 1/2 cup of flour with cocoa powder and add 1 1/2 cup chocolate chips
- Cheese Muffins: Add in 1 cup grated sharp cheddar cheese (more if you like it extra cheesy)
