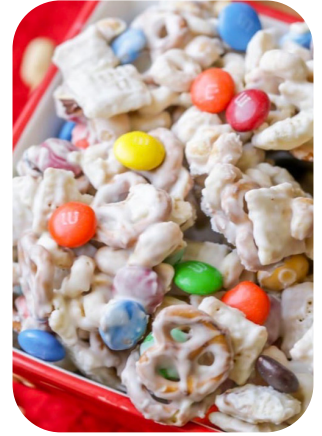

White Chocolate Party Mix

INGREDIENTS:

4 cups small pretzels
3 cups donut shapes oat cereal
3 cups Rice Krispie treats
12 oz milk chocolate chips or M & M's
1 cup rainbow sprinkles
24 oz white chocolate chips
3-4 Tablespoons vegetable oil



DIRECTIONS:

1. Mix the first 5 ingredients together in a large mixing bowl.
2. Combine the vegetable oil and white chocolate. Melt in glass bowl over a sauce pan with boiling water or in the microwave in 30 second intervals. Stir white chocolate until it is completely melted.
3. Pour melted chocolate over pretzel mixture and stir until everything is fully coated in white chocolate.
4. Spread everything out onto wax paper and wait for it to fully cool (10-15 minutes).
5. Break into chunks and place in an airtight container until eaten.

Bonus quick treat: can't wait? scoop into small bowls and eat with a spoon right away! Top with more sprinkles and chocolate syrup!
